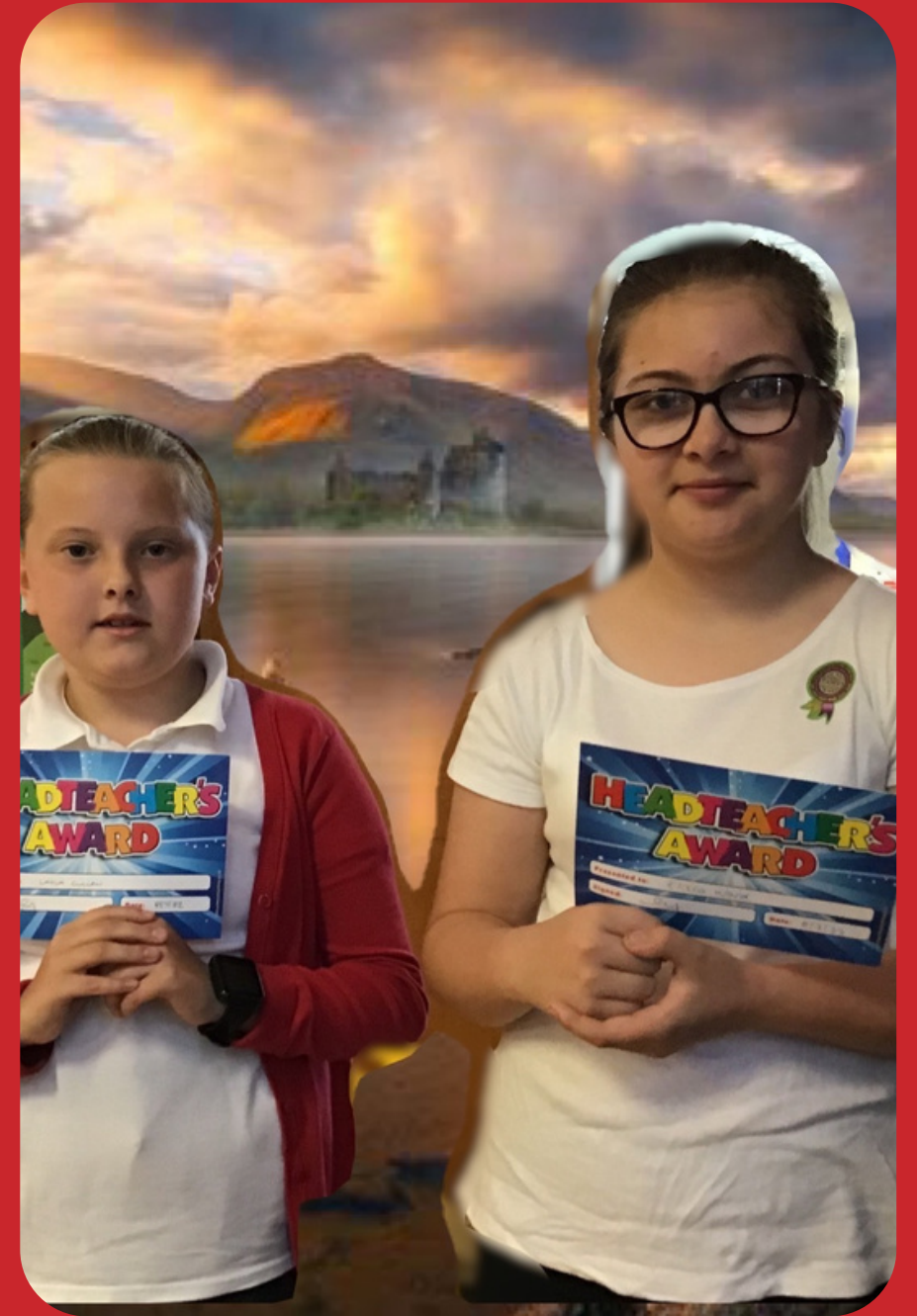

# Leaving staff...



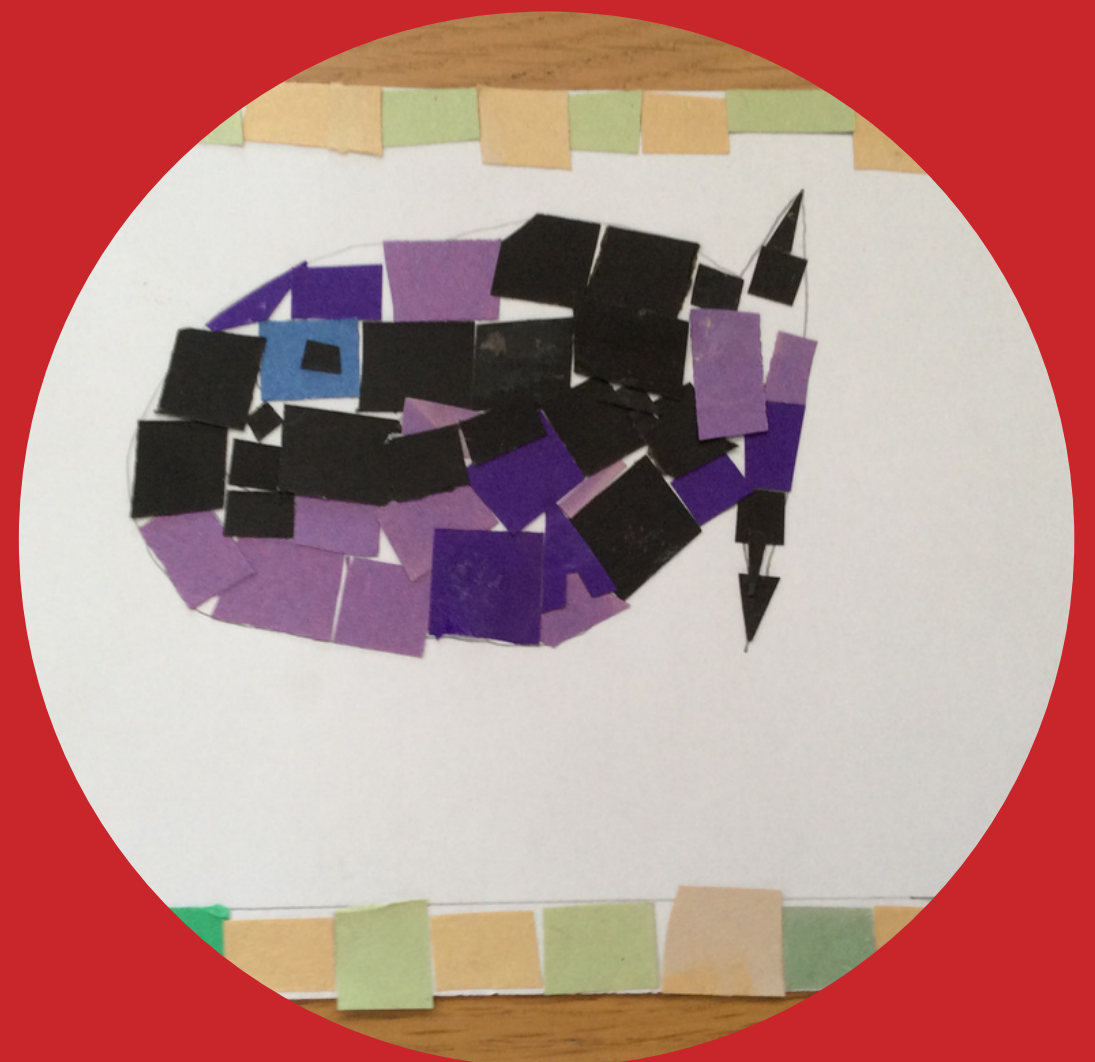
